Araminta Blue is an early career artist, who graduated from The Ruskin School of Art in 2012 and Chelsea College of Art in 2009. She has since been based in London, where she has been exhibiting her work and creating installations in venues across the city. When she's not creating art and exhibiting, Araminta makes regular research trips to countries such as Sri Lanka, Morocco and Japan, gathering materials and inspiration to use in her art and installations.

For Araminta, the act of painting in its purest sense is a source of joy. The speed with which a piece of art is executed and taken from concept to canvas is key to developing the finished artwork, and to her experience of producing her art. It allows her to capture the rawness of an idea in an action where she is reliant solely on herself and her tools. With a painting style that treads the line between classical and contemporary, Araminta pairs the familiar with the unfamiliar by placing domestic images in uncanny scenarios in order to present symbolic narratives.
