This season guests will have the chance to experience even more of the Ashcombe Estate over a whole weekend. Guy Ritchie has added two new bedroom suites to the six elegant farmhouse en-suite doubles, each furnished by interior designer, Edward Hurst, in the style of a nineteenth century New England shooting lodge.

The new rooms, 'Oliver' and 'Bishop', are situated on the top floor of the former brewery, offering spectacular views of Cranborne Chase; 380 square miles of rare chalk grasslands and ancient woodlands within a designated Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty and International Dark Sky Reserve.

Guests are invited to stay for two nights at a time, with breakfast included and a varied menu from Carousel available to order from the taproom throughout the weekend. There's also a bespoke sauna, wild swimming and yoga session on offer, alongside food and drink workshops from Carousel. The guest chef experience will take place in the lakeside WildKitchen on Saturday evening.

Eating & Drinking

BREAKFAST

Breakfast is included in your room rate and will be served on Saturday between 8am and 10.30am. Brunch will be served on Sunday from 10am (Bloody Marys will be available to order on the day, should the mood take you).

FRIDAY EVENING / SATURDAY LUNCHTIME

The taproom will be open from 5pm on Friday with an à la carte menu from Carousel and a wide selection of drinks available to order. We will contact you closer to the time to organise a table for you.

The bar will close at midnight on Friday and Saturday, but you're welcome to purchase nightcaps to take back to your room.

Light dishes will be available to order from the taproom on Saturday afternoon. Picnics can be purchased to enjoy in the grounds.

SATURDAY EVENING

The guest chef dinner begins at 6pm. Guests are invited to enjoy a drink on the brewery terrace from 5pm, before being taken to New Lake in the estate's gun bus. A drinks pairing will be available to order from the WildKitchen, in addition to a selection of wines, cocktails, ciders, beers and soft drinks. Please ask in advance for our list of fine wines.



The full line-up of guest chefs will be announced in the New Year.

DIETARY REQUIREMENTS

Vegetarian and gluten-free options are available as standard for our guest chef menus. We require advance notice of at least 72 hours. Every effort will be made to accommodate alternative dietary requirements but we cannot guarantee that there will be suitable options for every course of the guest chef's menu. If in doubt, please get in touch.

The breakfast and taproom menu will cater for all dietaries.

SERVICE CHARGE

A discretionary service charge of 13.5% will be added to your final tab.

WELLNESS & WORKSHOPS

A group yoga, sauna and wild lake swimming session can be booked for an additional £50pp (the session runs from 10am to 12pm).

Private sauna sessions, including treatment rooms, will be bookable for Saturday afternoon and Sunday morning. A full treatment menu will be made available in the spring.
