



Eating & Drinking

BREAKFAST

Breakfast is included in your room rate and will be served on Saturday in the Old Brewery between 8am and 10.30am. Weather permitting, you can enjoy breakfast on the terrace looking out over Cranbourne Chase.

Brunch will be served on Sunday from 10am (Bloody Marys will be available to order on the day, should the mood take you).

FRIDAY EVENING / SATURDAY LUNCHTIME

The Old Brewery will be open from 5pm on Friday with a varied menu of wood-fired bar snacks and small plates from the Carousel team and a wide selection of drinks available to order. We will contact you closer to the time to organise a table for you, but please do let us know of any dietary requirements in advance.

The bar will close at midnight on Friday and Saturday, but you're welcome to purchase nightcaps to take back to your room.

Light dishes will be available to order from the Old Brewery on Saturday afternoon.

SATURDAY EVENING

Dinner at the WildKitchen begins at 6pm. Guests are invited to enjoy a drink on the brewery terrace from 5pm, before being taken to New Lake in the estate's gun bus.

A drinks pairing will be available to order from the WildKitchen, in addition to a selection of wines, cocktails, ciders, beers and soft drinks. Please ask in advance for our list of fine wines.
