Joining us in the WildKitchen this summer we have another stellar line-up of culinary heavyweights who will each work their magic in the WildKitchen; Guy Ritchie's copper and canvas paean to fire, smoke and ash.

Before sundown on Saturday evening, you'll be driven down to New Lake in the estate's iconic gunbus, where you'll then spend the evening in the company of our guest chef that weekend. Over several hours, you'll enjoy a series of dishes cooked exclusively over fire and introduced, course by course, by the guest chef. Matched wines, beers and cocktails will be available to order as the evening wears on.

As night falls and the embers die down, you'll be taken back to the farmhouse for a nightcap in the communal sitting room before turning in.

Activities

You can enjoy the lakeside spa, nestled in perfect rural isolation. Offering a menu of treatments from expert therapists, the estate's wellness retreat was designed by and for the Ritchie family.

Detox in the fourteen-person bespoke sauna, fired by the estate's own ash trees, before diving into the crystal clear waters of the adjacent lake. Relish the peace and tranquillity, reconnecting with nature before the vibrancy of the evening begins.

Or you might like to wander the estate's footpaths, retracing the steps of the Bright Young Things as you stroll past Woodley Down, the old Rifle Range, Secret Valley and then south again from Win Green. Staff will be on hand to help you with maps and routes, and can point you in the direction of local points of interest should you decide to explore the local area further.

A group yoga, sauna and wild lake swimming session can be booked for an additional £50pp. Private sauna sessions, including treatment rooms, will be bookable for Saturday between 10am-4pm. A full treatment menu is available upon request.



About Ashcombe Estate

Ashcombe Estate is a working farm and family home set in 1,100 acres of rolling chalk downland. Named after the valleys (“combes”) filled with ash trees which cover much of the estate, to the north it meets Win Green - the highest point on Cranborne Chase - and to the south the village of Tollard Royal. It has housed numerous famous names including Cecil Beaton, who hosted many of the “Bright Young Things” during his residency, and is now the home of film maker Guy Ritchie and his family.

With a starring role in *The Gentlemen*, WildKitchen is the apotheosis of Guy Ritchie's passion for cooking over fire out in the elements. Fueled by lumpwood charcoal made on the estate from 100% local, sustainable-coppiced or naturally-fallen trees, and featuring the kind of temperature control and versatility you would normally only get with gas and electricity, the kitchen takes the art of barbecuing to the next level.
